

P PRIVACY POLICY

GOPIB SRL (“GoPIB Srl” “**Match-Me**”) is committed to protecting your privacy. This Privacy Policy explains how your personal information is collected, used and disclosed by GoPIB. This Privacy Policy applies to our websites, including without limitation, Match-Me pages, and any other websites that link to this Privacy Policy (collectively, our “**Sites**” or “**Service**”). By accessing or using our Service, you signify that you have read, understood and agree to our collection, storage, use and disclosure of your personal information as described in this Privacy Policy and our Terms of Use (<https://gopib.net/terms-conditions>). For the purposes of EU data protection laws (“**Data Protection Legislation**”), GoPIB is data controller (i.e., the company who is responsible for, and controls the processing of, your personal data).

Most important, our business model is predicated upon the idea of NOT TRAFFICKING any data.

In practical terms this means that our business model prevents GOPIB from selling any data to third parties.

The only revenue stream comes from clients like you, that support our “ethical” and “value adding” model by upgrading subscriptions to Premium, Basic Plus or Business.

You chose to share your data in the manner that provides the highest value to you, we simply facilitate the process.

- **WHAT INFORMATION DO WE COLLECT AND FOR WHAT PURPOSE?**

The categories of information we collect can include:

Information you provide to us directly. We collect personal information, such as your name, phone number, location, country, and e-mail address when you when you register for our Service, sign up for our mailing list, or otherwise communicate with us. We also collect any communications between you and GoPIB Srl and any other information you provide to GoPIB Srl, including without limitation, information about the data you input in your profile, your searches, your invitations and your connections.

Information we receive from third parties. From time to time, we may receive information about you from third parties and other users. We may also collect information about you that is publicly available.

We use this information to operate, maintain, and provide to you the features and functionality of the Service, as well as to communicate directly with you, such as to send you email messages and push notifications. We may also send you Service-related emails or messages (e.g., change or updates to features of the Service, technical and security notices).

Legal basis for processing in the EU

If you are a resident in the EU, we need to tell you the legal basis on which we collect and use your personal information. Please note that we will use the following such legal basis:

The provision of personal information by you may be necessary for the performance of any contractual relationship we have with you; or Where it is necessary for compliance with our legal obligations laid down by EU law; or Where in our legitimate interests provided these are not overridden by your interests and fundamental rights and freedoms (this includes our own legitimate interests and those of other entities and branches in our group of companies) for the following purposes: (i) to contact you and respond to your requests and enquiries; (ii) for business administration, including statistical analysis; (iii) to personalize your visit to the Sites; and (iv) for fraud prevention and detection and to comply with applicable laws, regulations or codes of practices.

We may ask for your consent for processing your personal information in relation to the Sites, in certain cases. You should be aware that you are entitled under Data Protection Law to withdraw your consent where that has been given, at any time. If you do this and we have no alternative lawful reason to process your personal data, this may affect our ability to provide you with rights to use the Sites.

In summary, we need certain categories of personal data in order to provide you with the Sites. Certain other personal data is processed for our legitimate interests in cases where this does not result in prejudice to you. Certain other personal data is processed based on consent.

- **HOW WE USE COOKIES AND OTHER TRACKING TECHNOLOGY TO COLLECT INFORMATION.**

We, and our third party partners, automatically collect certain types of usage information when you visit our Service, read our emails, or otherwise engage with us. We typically collect this information through a variety of tracking technologies, including cookies, web beacons, embedded scripts, location-identifying technologies, file information and similar technology (collectively, “**tracking technologies**”). For example, we collect information about your device and its software, such as your IP address, browser type, Internet service provider, platform type, device type, operating system, date and time stamp, a unique ID that allows us to uniquely identify your browser, mobile device or your account, and other such information. We also collect information about the way you use our Service, for example, the site from which you came and the site to which you are going when you leave our Site, the pages you visit, the links you click, how frequently you access the Service, whether you open emails or click the links contained in emails, whether you access the Service from multiple devices, and other actions you take on the Service. When you access our Service from a mobile device, we may collect unique identification numbers associated with your device or our mobile application (including, for example, a UDID, Unique ID for Advertisers (“IDFA”), Google AdID, or Windows Advertising ID), mobile carrier, device type, model and manufacturer, mobile device operating system brand and model, phone number, and depending on your mobile device settings, your geographical location data, including GPS coordinates (e.g., latitude and/or longitude) or similar information regarding the location of your mobile device, or we may be able to approximate a device’s location by analyzing other information, like an IP address. We may collect analytics data, or use third-party analytics tools, to help us measure traffic and usage trends for the Service and to understand more about the demographics of our users. We may also work with third party partners to employ technologies, including the application of statistical modeling tools, which permit us to recognize and contact you across multiple devices. Although we

do our best to honor the privacy preferences of our users, we are unable to respond to Do Not Track signals set by your browser at this time.

We use or may use the data collected through tracking technologies to: (a) remember information so that you will not have to re-enter it during your visit or the next time you visit the Site or Service; (b) provide custom, personalized content and information (c) recognize and contact you across multiple devices; (d) provide and monitor the effectiveness of our Service; (e) monitor aggregate metrics such as total number of visitors, traffic, usage, and demographic patterns on our Service; (f) diagnose or fix technology problems; and (g) otherwise to plan for and enhance our Service.

If you would prefer not to accept cookies, most browsers will allow you to: (i) change your browser settings to notify you when you receive a cookie, which lets you choose whether or not to accept it; (ii) disable existing cookies; or (iii) set your browser to automatically reject cookies. Please note that doing so may negatively impact your experience using the Service, as some features and services on our Service may not work properly. Depending on your mobile device and operating system, you may not be able to delete or block all cookies. You may also set your email options to prevent the automatic downloading of images that may contain technologies that would allow us to know whether you have accessed our email and performed certain functions with it.

We may employ third party companies and individuals to facilitate our Service ("Service Providers"), to provide the Service on our behalf, to perform Service-related services or to assist us in analyzing how our Service is used. These third parties have access to your Personal Data only to perform these tasks on our behalf and are obligated not to disclose or use it for any other purpose.

- **SHARING OF YOUR INFORMATION.**

We may share your personal information in the instances described below. For further information on your choices regarding your information, see the “**Control Over Your Information**” section below.

We enable sharing of the information you have chosen to make available to, for example your friends, friends of friends or the public. **However we do NOT sell any of your information to third parties under any circumstance.** The decision regarding which parts of your profile you make available to the public, friends or friends of friends is entirely yours.

Third parties as required by law or subpoena or if we reasonably believe that such action is necessary to (a) comply with the law and the reasonable requests of law enforcement; (b) to enforce our Terms of Use or to protect the security or integrity of our Service; and/or (c) to exercise or protect the rights, property, or personal safety of GoPIB Srl, our visitors, or others.

We may also share information with others in an aggregated or otherwise anonymized form that does not reasonably identify you directly as an individual.

- **CONTROL OVER YOUR INFORMATION.**

User Information Settings. You may update the information that you have provided in your profile at any time, included the privacy access rights.

How to control your communications preferences. You can stop receiving promotional email communications from us by clicking on the “unsubscribe link” provided in such communications. We make every effort to promptly process all unsubscribe requests. You may not opt out of service-related communications (e.g., changes/updates to features of the Service, technical and security notices).

Modifying or deleting your information. If you have any questions about reviewing, modifying, or deleting your information, you can contact us directly at BeYourWeb@GoPIB.com. You retain complete control to modify or delete your information in all circumstances.

Security Of Data. The security of your data is important to us, but remember that no method of transmission over the Internet, or method of electronic storage is 100% secure. While we strive to use commercially acceptable means to protect your Personal Data, we cannot guarantee its absolute security.

- **THIRD PARTY TRACKING AND ONLINE ADVERTISING.**

We DO NOT share, or permit third party online advertising networks, social media companies and other third party services, to collect, information about your use of our website. As noted above, depending on your browser or mobile device, you may be able set your browser to delete or notify you of cookies and other tracking technology by actively managing the settings on your browser or mobile device.

- **HOW WE STORE AND PROTECT YOUR INFORMATION**

Data storage and transfer. Your information collected through our Site may be stored and processed in the United States or any other country in which GoPIB Srl or its affiliates or service providers maintain facilities. If you are located in the European Union or other regions with laws governing data collection and use that may differ from U.S. law, please note that we may transfer information, including personal information, to a country and jurisdiction that does not have the same data protection laws as your jurisdiction, and we will take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that any personal data are treated securely and in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

For individuals based in the EU, we store personal data for as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes for which we collect the data (see above under "**WHAT INFORMATION DO WE COLLECT AND FOR WHAT PURPOSE?**") and in accordance with our legal obligations and legitimate business interest, except if required otherwise by law.

Keeping your information safe. We care about the security of your information and employ physical, administrative, and technological safeguards designed to preserve the integrity and security of all information collected through our Site and Service. However, no security system is impenetrable and we cannot guarantee the security of our systems 100%. In the event that any information under our control is compromised as a result of a breach of security, we will take reasonable steps to investigate the situation and, where appropriate, notify those individuals whose information may have been compromised and take other steps, in accordance with any applicable laws and regulations.

Security Controls

Physical controls: We are using a cloud server, if any breach activity, vulnerable activity happen at that time hosting provider inform us. Moreover, the organization reports a data breach within 72 hours to registered users. we are using tier 2 data center for IT infrastructure.

Procedural controls: Segregation of duties that are policies, procedures, and an organizational structure established so that one individual cannot control key aspects of computer-related operations and thereby conduct unauthorized actions or gain unauthorized access to assets or records.

Technical controls: We are using a two-way authentication process to access administrator level rights of cloud services as well as database, and also integrate firewall protection.

Service Providers: We may employ third party companies and individuals to facilitate our Service ("Service Providers"), to provide the Service on our behalf, to perform Service-related services or to assist us in analyzing how our Service is used. The third Party services are such as API, email services, chat services, payment gateway, Google analytics etc...

These third parties have access to your Personal Data only to perform these tasks on our behalf and are obligated not to disclose or use it for any other purpose.

- **CHILDREN'S PRIVACY**

GoPIB Srl does not knowingly collect or solicit any information from anyone under the age of 13 on this Service. In the event that we learn that we have inadvertently collected personal information from a child under age 13, we will delete that information as quickly as possible.
